

ASHRAE Asia Pacific Conference on Region XIII the Built Environment

Asia Pacific Conference on the Built Environment (APCBE) is a biennial event of ASHRAE Region XIII and it was first launched back in 1991. In response to the growing technology, the Conference scope has been expanded from HVAC&R to cover various aspects related to the built environment. This international conference provides an excellent platform for researchers and practitioners to share ideas, best practice, new technologies and future prospects.

The 15th APCBE on Built Environment which was organised by ASHRAE Taiwan Chapter and held on 17-18 October 2019 in Hansin Arena 9F, Kaohsiung. This was a 2day conference with participants from academics, architects, building owners, consultants, contractors, facilities managers, government, industries, suppliers and other parties who have interest in design, installation, testing, commissioning, operation and maintenance of the built environment.
